The Squaw Valley Chapel, built for the 1960 Winter Olympics and restored to its original glory in 2003, is a uniquely dramatic and intimate setting for a wedding in any season of the year. As a United Church of Christ (a progressive Protestant denomination) we welcome **all** people of all faith traditions.

The **sanctuary** featuring soaring windows and mountain views, seats 100 people and up to 150 with additional chairs in the entry hall. We can accommodate indoor weddings for up to 200 guests with combined seating and standing.

Our beautiful outdoor **lawn and deck** accommodates over 200 guests for weddings, 150 for receptions, or 100 for outdoor wedding and reception.

Our **Gallery** room accommodates receptions for up to 50 people seated, or up to 100 for more casual standing receptions.

To reserve your wedding and/or reception at the Church of Squaw Valley, please print, complete and mail the reservation and wedding agreement with a 50% deposit for your desired services. Once your reservation, agreement and deposit are received, you will be mailed a signed copy with a confirmation letter.

Our minister, Reverend Art Domingue, can perform your ceremony, or you may choose your own person to officiate.
